# Pet Policy for Bethany Park

Pets are welcome after Waitangi weekend to 15<sup>th</sup> December on sites only. We ask you to **please** respect our policies so we can continue to welcome your pets at Bethany Park.

- No pets in or around the accommodation / camp kitchens / buildings, sites only.
- Dogs must **always be on a lead in campground** and doggy dos picked up.
- If your pet is left unattended in your caravan/motorhome and creates a disturbance for those around you, you may be asked to leave the camp.
- Pets must be on a lead on the Loop Track and on the road through the Storage area.
- Pet blankets can be washed in the allocated washing machine in Camp 2.
- All dog owners are responsible for keeping their dogs under strict control to ensure they don't bother people or other dogs.
- An authorised Therapy dog is permitted to be in accommodation with their owner. Please ask to see official documentation. A cash bond is not necessary with documentation.

## Dog exercise area at Bethany and locally:

1. Camp Two: Back of golf paddock and Back paddock as per signs – Pet Exercise area
2. Little Kaiteriteri beach and Stephens Bay:  
1<sup>st</sup> March -30<sup>th</sup> November all day; 1<sup>st</sup> December-1<sup>st</sup> March, 5am-9am only
3. Tapu Bay, off Stephens Bay Road, all year round
4. **Please note: Dogs are not permitted on the main Kaiteriteri Beach at any time.**

**It is our policy that no pets are permitted in the cabins. IF someone arrives with their pet and must stay, or we discover they have a pet, they will be asked to pay a \$100.00 cash bond which is refunded on their departure once the cabin is checked by our Cleaning Team. The Garden Motel in Motueka welcomes pets into cabins.**
